Week Five– (Fifth Sunday of the month through the following Saturday)

“REVIVAL AND SPIRITUAL WARFARE” – 2 Corinthians 10:4-6; Luke 10:18, Ephesians 1: 20-23

Warfare Prayer – Spiritual Warm ups and Stretching

1. Help me to know Jesus' authority as I pray warfare. **Colossians 2:15 – “And having disarmed the powers and authorities (that control the airwaves), he made a public spectacle of them triumphing over them by the cross”**
2. Help me know my position as a child of God as I do prayer warfare. – **Ephesians 2:6 – “And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus”. Philippians 1:16 “...knowing that I am put here for the defense of the gospel”**
3. Help me to know that I am fighting in the spirit realm as I do prayer warfare. **Ephesians 6:12 – “For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realm”.**
4. Help me to know that as a child of God I am called to demolish strongholds as I do prayer warfare. **2 Corinthians 10:3-5 – “For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ”**
5. Help me to know that now is the time for Satan and all his influence to be driven out as I do prayer warfare. **John 12:31 – “Now is the time for judgment on this world, now the prince of this world will be driven out”.**
6. Help me know that I have the keys to the Kingdom of Heaven as I do prayer warfare. - **Matthew 16:19 - “I will give you the keys of the Kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven”**
7. Help me to know the will of God is to be done on earth as it is in heaven as I do prayer warfare. **Matthew 6:9,10 – “This then is how you should pray; Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be your name, thy kingdom come, they will be done on earth as it is done in heaven”**
8. Help me to see Satan's strongholds broken as I do prayer warfare. **Luke 10:18, 19 – “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy, nothing will harm you”**
9. Help me to see during the warfare prayer that the children of God are the absolute key to healing to our land. **2 Chronicles 7:14 – “If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land”**

The following are things to bind up and to loose in our spiritual warfare. (Bind up everything in the left hand column and loose the things that are in the right hand column)

Bind – (break Satan’s power)

(Matthew 16:19; “I will give you the keys of the Kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven”)
